DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop and maintain mine plans and obtain required mine permits.
- Identify and manage consultants as required for mine planning, reclamation and permitting.
- Review and approve all mine and reclamation plans.
- Complete reclamation surety evaluations and coordinate the posting of surety for mining/quarrying/manufacturing facilities.
- Provide estimates of actual reclamation costs as required for calculation of Graymont's asset retirement obligations (ARO).
- Maintain a database of all mine/reclamation plans and permit requirements for all Graymont lime manufacturing.
- Annually verify reserve volumes at each Graymont quarry based on current information, and submit reports to the COO, VP's Manufacturing, VP Environmental, Director of Geologic Services and others as required.
- Provide technical assistance and training for quarry supervision including but not limited to:
 - Understanding and following mine plans; survey control; reclamation techniques; and computer applications for mine/reclamation plans.
- Annually review and audit each facility's safety, production, and reclamation performance.
- Submit board reports to the COO, Vice Presidents of Manufacturing, Vice President Environmental, Director, Mining and Geology, and others as required.
- Audit royalty payments and calculations at quarries.
- Travel required up to 20 % mostly in Western Canada. Must be eligible to get passport and visa.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- B.S. or higher degree in Mining Engineering or related technical degree with minimum three years experience in mine planning.
- Working knowledge of mine planning computer applications; Gemcom software preferred.
- Strong communication and team skills and well organized.
- French language skills are an asset.
- Must be meticulous and able to work independently.
- Must possess strong understanding of mining equipment and mine safety procedures.
